693 participations, 310 grants, €123.6 million of EU funding to African Union partners

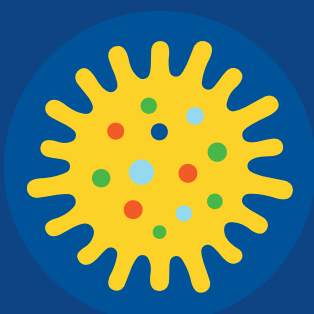
905 researchers from African Union countries involved in Marie Skłodowska-Curie actions

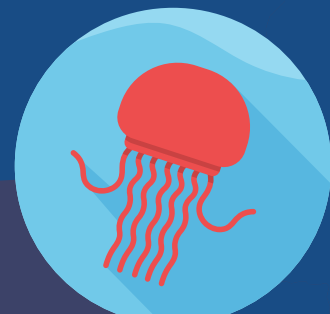

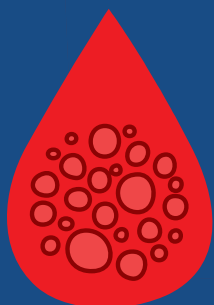

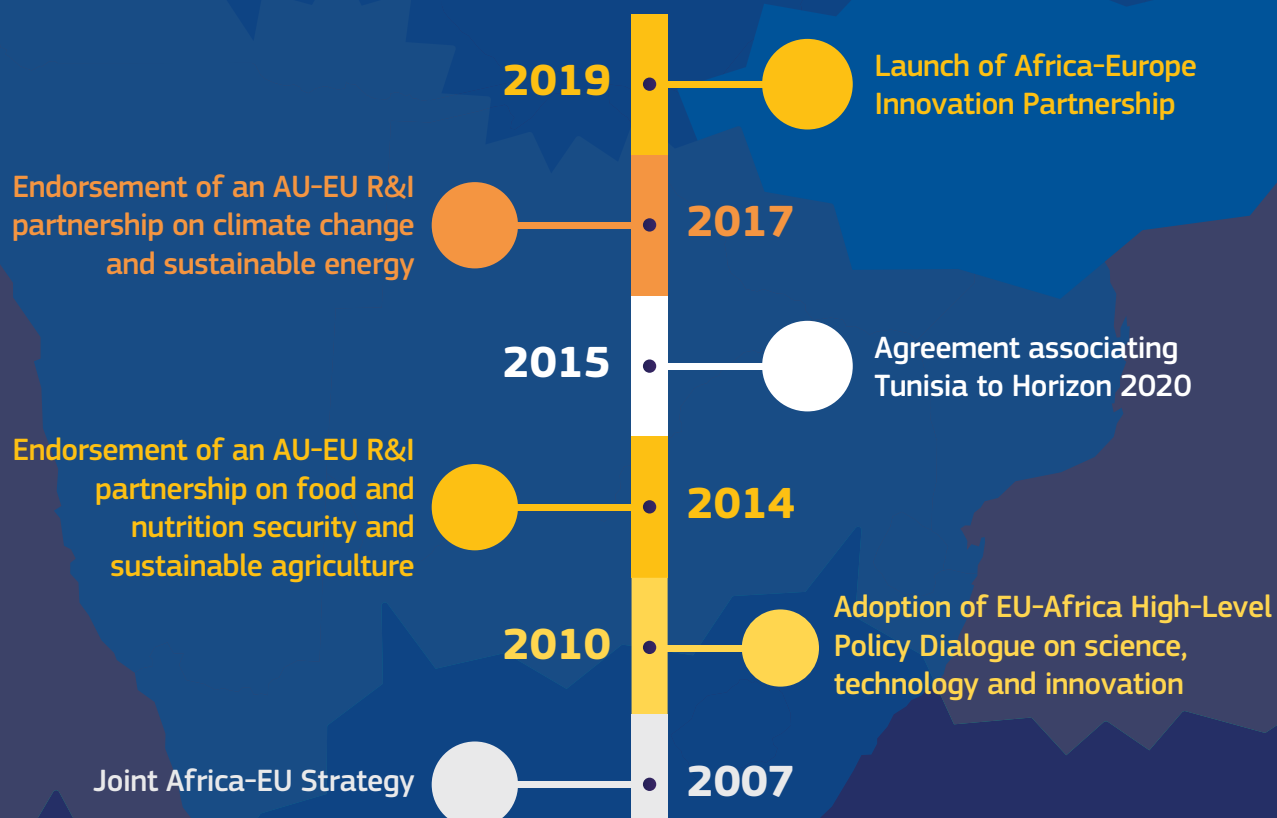
