## **European Capital of Innovation Awards 2019 – learning session**

With their capacity to connect people, places, public and private actors, urban areas are the **engines of economic growth and innovation in Europe**. Through their everyday activities, cities are advancing innovation, supporting business developments, and improving the lives of their citizens. By offering platforms for experimenting and engaging citizens at all levels of governance and stages of innovation, they ensure that their innovative outputs the best address problems of their inhabitants.

European Capital of Innovation Awards celebrates European cities that are **pushing the boundaries of innovation**. The prize identifies inclusive urban ecosystems that successfully translate their results into **improved wellbeing of citizens**. In particular, the award recognises the cities that are making the most to promote innovation in their communities by involving various actors, and especially citizens, in decision-making, and using innovation to improve the resiliency and sustainability of their cities.

With this award, the EU wishes to raise awareness about the benefits of urban innovation 'with' and 'for' citizens, supporting cities in addressing relevant societal challenges, and strengthening their urban resilience.

The 5<sup>th</sup> European Capital of Innovation Awards was launched by Carlos Moedas, Commissioner for Research, Science and Innovation, with a video address at 'Athens: iCapital 2018' event in Athens on 20 February. The award generates high visibility for cities, in the form of renewed public interest and increased media coverage, and foresees six monetary prizes:
