Expert Sounding Board Meeting hosted by the Group of Scientific Advisors of the European Commission's Scientific Advice Mechanism (SAM)

13 February 2020, Frere-Orban Square 8, Brussels

MEETING REPORT¹

An Expert Sounding Board meeting brings together members of the Group of Chief Scientific Advisors and a select group of scientific experts with a wide distribution of relevant expertise. It will inform the deliberations of the Group of Chief Scientific Advisors on their Scientific Opinion.

The experts that participated in the meeting were Tim Benton (Chatham House), Hamid El Bilali (Mediterranean Agronomic Institute of Bari, CIHEAM IAM), Adrian Leip (European Commission Joint Research Centre, JRC) and Peter Oosterveer (Wageningen University and Research, WUR). The meeting was co-chaired by Chief Scientific Advisors Carina Keskitalo, Rolf Heuer and Janusz Bujnicki, with support from staff of the SAM secretariat.

All experts had received a preliminary draft of the recommendations of the Group of Chief Scientific Advisors. The Group of Chief Scientific Advisors sought the views of four scientific experts, acting in their personal capacity on the scope, accuracy, clarity, feasibility, and order of importance of these draft recommendations and on further evidence-based considerations.

None of the experts were members of the SAPEA Working Group authoring the Evidence Review Report underpinning the Scientific Opinion. However, the experts were aware of the evidence presented by the SAPEA Working Group, as they had received the draft Evidence Review Report and had all participated in the SAPEA expert workshop on 8 November 2019, in which an early draft of the Evidence Review Report was reviewed and discussed in detail. The experts additionally contributed by the sharing of their own knowledge and expertise and the provision of additional policy-relevant scientific evidence.

The Chief Scientific Advisors thank the experts for the helpful, insightful and constructive contributions.
